



## Notice of Race

**Capri 25 - Catalina 25/250  
National Regatta  
September 12-14, 2014  
Lake Minnetonka - Wayzata Yacht Club  
Wayzata, MN**

You and your crew are invited to the 2014 National Regatta, sailed on beautiful Lake Minnetonka. The facilities of the Wayzata Yacht Club offer free crane use for put-in and take-out. Hosted by the Capri 25 fleet of the Wayzata Yacht Club, known for its competitive sailing and social activities.

### Rules

- The Wayzata Yacht Club is the Organizing Authority.
- The races will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2013-2016, except as modified by the Sailing Instructions and any amendments thereto.
- Each fleet shall employ all class rules, except as specifically modified by the Sailing Instructions. The Sailing Instructions will take precedence in case of conflict.
- Crew count declarations, identifying the total crew count for each day of racing shall be submitted at registration.

### Eligibility

This regatta is open to all boats of the Capri 25, Catalina 25 and Catalina 250 classes that:

- meet the measurement criteria of their class.
- are covered by paid up marine liability insurance of at least \$300,000.
- have a member in good standing of the International Association in accordance with Fleet Rule, Association Bylaws and Constitution.

### Classification

All skippers and crew will comply with ISAF Group 1 Sailor Classification Code (See Rule 79 RRS.)

### **Measurement Waivers**

Measurement waivers may be granted to participants that complete and submit a waiver form prior to the close of registration. If granted, a waiver may include a PHRF adjustment. Measurement Waiver Forms are available on the web site and will also be available at registration.

### **Entry Forms and Fees**

In an effort to increase participation, the Wayzata Yacht Club Capri 25 Fleet is generously offering to waive regatta registration fees 100% for all out-of-town boats. We realize there are costs involved when traveling with a boat, so only the local WYC boats will pay the entry fees.

10:00 AM – Warning signal for first race. Up to 4 races back to back.  
Lunch on the water.  
4:30 PM - Social hour & refreshments.
- **Saturday 9/13**  
7:30 – 9:00 AM - Continental breakfast.  
10:00 AM – Warning signal for first race. Up to 4 races back to back.  
Lunch on the water.

4:30 PM - Social hour & refreshments.

- **Sunday 9/14**

10:00AM - Warning signal for first race. Up to 2 races back to back. No warning

after approximately 12:30 PM.

2:00 PM - Refreshments, award ceremony, and crane out.

### **Scoring**

The Low Point scoring system, RRS Appendix A will be used. One race is required to be completed to constitute a series. If five or more races are completed, each yacht's worst score will be excluded.

### **Sailing Instructions**

The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

### **Racing Fleets**

While the desire is to race each class in separate fleets, a minimum of three eligible boats will be required to establish a fleet. If a class has less than three participants then a combined fleet will be created using PHRF ratings.

### **Trophies**

Trophies will be awarded for each fleet based on participation:

- 1<sup>st</sup> Place trophy (three participants)
- 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> Place trophies (five participants)
- 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> Place trophies (seven participants)
- 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> Place trophies (nine participants)
- 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> Place trophies (eleven or more participants)
